

**THE PERFECT MIX: AFRICAN ADVENTURE MEETS  
BUSH LUXURY  
Namibian Fly-In Safari**

Day 1	<p>Arrival at 08h45am at <b>Hosea Kutako International Airport</b>. Transfer via <b>Windhoek</b> (including a short sightseeing tour) to <b>GocheGanas</b> Nature Reserve &amp; Wellness Village app. 40km south of Windhoek.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: GocheGanas – Elegant Suite. FB</b> <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. 90km/1h</b></p>
Day 2 & 3	<p>Two days to relax and adjust to Namibia. First encounters with the <b>African wilderness</b> with many <b>game sightings</b>. There is also a possibility to enjoy one or other <b>treatment</b> at the in-house <b>wellness centre</b>. (Not included in the package)</p> <p><b>Accommodation: GocheGanas – Elegant Suite. FB</b> <b>Distance/Travel Duration: none</b></p>
Day 4	<p>After breakfast transfer to <b>Windhoek's Eros Airport</b>. Flight with a Cessna 210 in northern direction to <b>Okonjima Lodge</b>, home to the <b>Africat Foundation</b>. Transfer to the <b>Bush Camp</b>. In the afternoon first game drive that introduces us to the world of Namibian <b>cheetahs</b> and <b>leopards</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Okonjima – Bush Suite. FB</b> <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. 40km/2hrs</b></p>
Day 5	<p>In the early morning there is the possibility of joining the <b>Bushmen Trail</b>, a comprehensive introductory tour to the life of the <b>San (Bushmen) people</b> in Namibia. A further game drive with a focus on the <b>Africat Project</b> also forms part of the agenda today.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Okonjima – Bush Suite. FB</b> <b>Distance/Travel Duration: none</b></p>
Day 6	<p>We fly to northern Namibia to reach <b>Mushara Lodge</b>, located at the eastern gate to <b>Etosha National Park</b>. In the afternoon we undertake a game drive in Etosha National Park, where we collect our first impressions of <b>Namibia's diverse fauna</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Mushara Outpost FB</b> <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. 1,5hrs</b></p>
Day 7	<p>Today we embark on another <b>game drive</b> in <b>Etosha National Park</b>, focusing on the surroundings of <b>Namutoni</b>. Next to <b>Oryx, zebra, springbok, kudu</b> and other antelopes it is likely that we might be lucky enough to view <b>elephants</b> and even <b>lions</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Mushara Outpost. FB</b> <b>Distance/travel Duration: Excursions app. 4hrs</b></p>

Day 8	<p>In the early morning we depart in western direction to fly to the <b>Namibian coast</b>. Arrival in <b>Swakopmund</b> and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day will be spent taking a stroll through town, maybe visiting the <b>museum</b>, the <b>Kristallgalerie</b> or just taking a relaxing walk along the beach.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Hansa Hotel. HB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. 3hrs</b></p>
Day 9	<p>Transfer to Swakopmund Airport in the late morning. Scenic flight over the <b>Skeleton Coast</b>, the large <b>Sandwich Harbor Lagoon</b> and <b>Sossusvlei</b> with its highest dunes in the world, to <b>Wolwedans</b> in the <b>Namib Desert</b>. Transfer to <b>Wolwedans Dune Camp</b>. In the late afternoon <b>sundowner drive in the dunes</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Wolwedans Dune Camp. FB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. km / 2hrs</b></p>
Day 10	<p>A Namibian truth: <b>the desert lives</b>. This is the mantra for our extended <b>nature drive</b> today. A desert experience of extraordinary value composed by breathtaking vistas of <b>red sand dunes</b>, <b>gravel plains</b> and <b>endless wide-open space</b>, dotted with <b>ostrich</b>, <b>springbok</b> and <b>Oryx</b>, antelopes that survive nearly without water here. Picnic lunch at the <b>Hard Rock Café</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Wolwedans Dune Camp. FB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: Day excursion</b></p>
Day 11	<p>Another day at Wolwedans Dune Camp in <b>NamibRand Nature Reserve</b>, the largest <b>private nature reserve</b> in Namibia. We relax and enjoy being in this beautiful landscape. Further drives are possible.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Wolwedans Dune Camp. FB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: ca. 0km/h</b></p>
Day 12	<p>After breakfast we depart from Wolwedans and fly to <b>Farm Kiripotib (Familie von Hase)</b>, app. 160km southeast of Windhoek. In the late afternoon <b>game drive and sundowners</b> in the farm's game enclosure.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Guest Farm Kiripotib - Chalet. FB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. km / 2h</b></p>
Day 13	<p>One day to relax and unwind on <b>Farm KIRIPOTIB</b> after the magnificent fly-in safari. To fill your time you have the opportunity to visit the farm workshops including the <b>African KIRIKARA weavery, gallery and jewellery design studio</b>.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Guest Farm Kiripotib - Chalet FB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: none</b></p>
Day 14	<p>After an extensive breakfast we drive to <b>Windhoek</b>. Time for a little stroll around town and maybe some sight seeing.</p> <p><b>Accommodation: Pension Palmquell. AB</b>  <b>Distance/Travel Duration: app. 160 km/2hrs</b></p>
Day 15	<p>Early morning transfer to <b>Hosea Kutako International Airport</b> for departure back home.</p>

### **CONDITIONS OF TRAVEL AND GENERAL ADVICE**

Our price offer of N\$ 45.500.00 **per person in a group of max. 4 people** (1.00 Euro roughly corresponds to 9-10 N\$) includes all suggested activities and accommodations as well as all meals mentioned on the travel itinerary. Single rooms will go at an extra charge of N\$ 5.950. **The fixed price does not include the return flights to Namibia** All further costs generated by Safari - bound activities **like permits and Namibian special taxes are included.**

We provide **lunchpacks** and refreshing drinks for longer drives.

All **vehicle costs** as well as the charge for **personal guides**, who are qualified, knowledgeable and in command of necessary languages, **are included.**

**Excluded** are all **alcoholic beverages as well as non-alcoholic beverages** that are not provided by the tour guide during long drives and **all personal expenses** of our guests.

**Luggage is limited to a maximum of 20 kg** per person in **soft bags**. It is ideal to take a small backpack/bag for cameras and amenities. Hand luggage is limited to **10 kg** per person.

It is recommended that guests arrange for a **Travel Insurance** as well **insurance for loss of luggage or accidents** before the trip. Your travel agent can advise you on the best options for travel insurances.

The **deadline** for booking a safari is two (2) months before the start of the safari. If there are not enough participants for a safari or the safari has to be cancelled according to other obstacles, we will do our best to organize an alternative for you. Should you decline our suggested alternatives, we will refund you entirely for payments that have already been made.

Transactions with a **Credit Card** are not always possible.

For your safety and comfort **african KIRIKARA safaris** reserves the right to:

- **Change aspects of a safari** and substitute these with equally interesting/valuable experiences in case of bad weather or unforeseen circumstances. Game viewing is dependent on weather circumstances as well as time of day, year, season and cannot be guaranteed.
- **exclude a member of a safari** if the logistics as well as peace and harmony of the trip are repeatedly being disturbed by the member's behaviour and/or attitude. In this case **african KIRIKARA safaris** will charge the full price of the trip.

During our safaris we sometimes cross through **uncharted territory**, which is not indicated on a map. Having to turn around and **choose another route** is part of the excitement of being on Safari. Apart from the major tarred roads, most roads in Africa hold a surprise or two.

We take every **precaution** to assure that our vehicles are in **perfect mechanical condition**. We can also assure you that the roads that we choose to travel are the best suited ones under any circumstances. We can, however, not guarantee that **technical problems** may not occur altogether or that we don't have to effect a **change of route** due to unforeseen circumstances. In case of these inconveniences we cannot be held **responsible**.

Please note that our **services** are limited to the **itinerary offered**.

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Our Travel groups have a limit of **four and a maximum of fourteen members**. More than seven people requires the use of **a second vehicle**. We only make use of 4x4 vehicles such as **Land Rovers, Land Cruisers or VW Kombis**.

In the case of **currency fluctuations** african KIRIKARA safaris reserves the right to adjust prices.

**CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT:**

20% of the full fee has to be paid when booking. The rest needs to be paid **eight weeks prior to first day of the booked tour**.

**CANCELLATION BY CLIENTS/ CHANGES OF ITINERARY:**

(Only cancellations forwarded in written form will be processed)

Cancellation fees:

- Up to 31 days before beginning of scheduled tour maximum of 10%
- 30 to 21 days before beginning of scheduled tour maximum of 25%
- 20 to 11 days before beginning of scheduled tour maximum of 40%
- 10 to 0 days before beginning of scheduled tour maximum of 60% of full booking fee.
- Clients who do not turn up on the day of the beginning of the scheduled tour will be liable to pay 100 % of the booking fee

In individual cases higher cancellation fees than the ones given above may also be charged - the tour operator reserves the right to do so if he can prove it necessary.

If a cancellation occurs due to medical reasons, a doctor's certificate is necessary to process the cancellation.
